



Frequently Asked Questions

ATV Tours near Banff – Alberta – Field, BC Tours

Forest & Falls - Beginner
Mountain & Meadows - Intermediate

Q: How long is the trip?

A: Forest & Falls – Beginner 3 hours round trip from the base located in Field BC.
Mountain & Meadows – Intermediate 5 hours round trip from the base located in Field BC.

Q: Where is the ATV Base located?

A: The ATV and Zipline base is Located 65 minutes West of Banff on Highway # 1. 2810 Beaverfoot Road near Field, BC.

Traveling from the East: We are located 56 kilometers west of Lake Louise on Highway #1, exit left onto Beaverfoot Road. You will see our Awesome All Season Adventures reception within 30 seconds. Watch for tour signs.

Traveling from the West: We are located 26 kilometers east of Golden on Highway #1, exit right onto Beaverfoot Road. You will see our Awesome All Season Adventures reception within 30 seconds. Watch for tour signs.

Q: What are the restrictions?

A: Children must be 16 years old to drive an ATV. Passengers must be at least 6 years old.

Q: What is the price of an ATV Tours?

A: Current season prices are available on our website <http://www.canadianoutback.com/banff-atv-tours.php>. There is also an optional \$25 insurance fee.

Q: What should I wear on the trip?

A: Closed-toe sturdy footwear and clothing appropriate for the weather and backcountry travel that day (i.e. long sleeves and pants to protect skin from scratching against branches, gloves, sunglasses & sunscreen). We provide helmets that are mandatory to be worn. We have limited coveralls, rubber boots, and safety glasses available for use.

Q: Can I bring a camera on with me?

A: Cameras are encouraged, but be aware that ATVing can be dusty, bumpy and dirty so delicate and large cameras are better left behind. Small inexpensive pocket cameras are best.

Q: Can I bring a bag with me?

A: Yes, you may bring a small back pack or fanny pack if you wish. Hanging bags or purses are not recommended.

Q: Where and when do I check in?

A: We require you to check in 15 minutes prior to your tour departure at 2810 Beaverfoot Road near Field, BC at the Awesome All Seasons Adventure base

Q: Do you provide transportation?

A: There is no transportation provided for this tour. You are required to get yourself to the check in desk.

Q: How many people do you take on tour at a time?

A: We take up to 7 people per tour guide. Total numbers depend on bookings that day.

Q: If it's raining will the trip still run?

A: Trips run rain or shine. Please be sure to check the weather prior to your departure and dress appropriately in wet weather rain gear.

Q: What is your refund policy?

A: This tour is non refundable within 48 hours of departure and 2 weeks non refundable for group bookings of 10 or more.

Q: Do I have to pre book/pay?

A: Yes, we take full payment via credit card at the time of booking. Pre booking is mandatory to ensure your space on the tour.

Q: Can I still take this tour even if I've never done ATVing before?

A: If you wish to take the moderate tour we do recommend you have some riding experience. If you have never experienced ATVing before, please consider the beginner style tour.

Q: What time of year do ATV tours run?

A: May to October (based on weather conditions).

Q: How far in advance do I have to book?

A: We take bookings months in advance or even the day before. It is up to you how last minute you want to leave your booking. By leaving it to the last minute, you take the risk that there will not be any space left during the tour time which you desire.
