



## Frequently Asked Questions

### Peak 2 Peak Gondola in Whistler BC

**Q: How long does it take?**

A: We recommend you give yourself at least 2 hours to enjoy your Peak 2 Peak Alpine experience.

**Q: Where do the trips start?**

A: You may pick up your discounted Peak 2 Peak ticket at the Whistler Blackcomb Guest Services building in the Gondola Building at the Base of Whistler Mountain or at the Blackcomb Day Lodge located in the Upper Village. Upload access is available from the Village via the Whistler Village Gondola or from the Blackcomb Base on the Wizard Express Chairlift.

**Q: What time of year does the Peak 2 Peak Gondola run?**

A: The Peak 2 Peak is open during the summer months from May to September and in the winter months from November to April. The Peak 2 Peak closes for several weeks at the end of each season for maintenance. Please check our updated website for specific open and closing dates which change yearly.

**Q: How much is it for Peak 2 Peak Tickets?**

**Q: What should I wear on the trip?**

A: You should wear appropriate clothes depending on the weather. Please note it is several degrees cooler up on the mountain and the weather can change quickly. You should be prepared for wind, rain and snow up the top. Dress in warm layers, bring a wind or rain jacket/shell and wear closed toed footwear, preferably waterproof hiking boots or shoes.

**Q: What's the climate like in the Whistler area in the summer?**

A: Whistler lies within the Coast Mountain Range, an area characterized by moderate temperatures and heavy precipitation. Our seasonal rains mean that our mountains are lush with plant growth throughout the summer. Temperatures vary dramatically between the lowland coastal and the adjacent alpine area. On the same day that shorts will be appropriate in Whistler Village, you'll want to be equipped with warm layers in the mountains.

**Q: Do I need to purchase a separate lift ticket to get to your Peak 2 Peak Gondola?**

A: No. The Peak 2 Peak ticket includes your lift access to the top of the mountain.

**Q: What is your refund policy?**

A: Peak 2 Peak tickets are non refundable at the time of booking.

**Q: Do I have to pre book/pay?**

A: We take full payment via credit card at the time of booking. Pre booking is required to receive the discounted rate. Peak 2 Peak tickets can also be purchased from any Whistler Blackcomb ticket window in the Village during your stay.

**Q: How far in advance do I have to book?**

A: Discounted Peak 2 Peak tickets must be reserved at least 3 days prior to your required date.
