



Frequently Asked Questions

Whistler Tasting Tours in Whistler, BC

Q: How much food is there on tour?

A: There is definitely enough food for even the most ravenous appetites on both the Finer Things Tour and the Hidden Gems Tour.

Q: Do you accommodate vegetarians and/or allergies?

A: Yes. Just let us know when making your reservation.

Q: What's the difference between the two dinner tours?

A: The main difference between the two tours is the selected Whistler restaurants we visit. The Hidden Gems Tour focuses more on local favorites while the Finer Things Tour focus more on higher end fine dining. They are both fantastic and have received equal interest so rest assured there is no bad decision.

Q: How long are we at each restaurant?

A: On the dinner tours we are at each venue for approximately 30 minutes. The restaurants are always ready for our groups with the food and wine, so there's nothing rushed about the experience.

Q: How do we travel between restaurants?

A: We walk between all the restaurants, but they are never more than a few minutes apart (and if it's raining the guide will have umbrellas for everyone). Tours run rain or shine!

Q: What is your minimum and maximum group size?

A: Minimum is 2 people and maximum is 15 people on the regular tours. However, we can accommodate much larger groups (upwards of 100 people) with enough advance notice.

Q: How much does a tour cost?

A: Prices vary depending on which tour you decide to take. All of our prices are listed on the website. Please refer to the following link.

Q: What time and where do the tours start?

A: The check in location and time can vary according to the season. Once your booking is finalized we will send you check in details and directions.

Q: Do you have a hotel pick-up service?

A: No. Our guides will meet guests at the departure location. All departure locations are in Whistler village and easy to find.

Q: How long are the tours?

A: The dinner tours are about 3 hours, but guests often stay at the last venue for a few more drinks as they are enjoying themselves.

Q: Can I come on tour if I don't drink alcohol?

A: Definitely. The food alone is worth coming out on tour.

Q: How old do I have to be to come on tour?

A: We keep the regular tours to adults 19 years of age or older. However, we can often arrange private tours for families that would like to include their children that are younger.

Q: Is there a dress code?

A: No, restaurants in Whistler will cater to everything from ski suits to fancy dinner wear. However, the most common is smart casual. Also, guests should wear comfortable footwear for walking between restaurants in the village and dress weather appropriate.

Q: Do you accommodate guests with disabilities?

A: Yes. If you are mobility restricted or in a wheelchair we can use ramp accesses to all the restaurants on our Hidden Gems Tour. For hearing impaired guests we can provide written material.

Q: What is your refund policy?

A: Refunds will not be given within 48 hours of the tour and 2 weeks non-refundable for group bookings of 10 or more people.

Q: Do I have to pre book/pay?

A: We take full payment via credit card at the time of booking. Pre booking is recommended to ensure your space on the tour.

Q: How far in advance do I have to book?

A: We take bookings months in advance or even the day before. It is up to you how last minute you want to leave your booking. By leaving it to the last minute, you take the risk that there will not be any space left during the tour time which you desire.
