ELAHO EXHILARATOR RAFTING FOR CADETS

One of our most popular adventures, this rafting trip is ideal if you're looking for an exciting and memorable outdoor experience. Although the trip features numerous Class 3-4 rapids on the Elaho and Squamish rivers, it's still suitable for everyone, including those with little or no rafting experience. The 2-3 hours on the river feature lots of big waves crashing into the boats, and what's been voted as Canada's best rafting scenery. To top it all off we end with an optional delicious BBQ meal back at our comfortable adventure base near the rivers.

AGE & SKILL REQUIREMENTS

Participants must be **13 years of age or older and weigh a minimum of 90 pounds / 40kg** to take part in this adventure. You don't need to have any previous rafting experience or any special skills to fully enjoy this trip. People who are definitely not at least comfortable in and around water should not participate. Everyone will be required to sign a waiver. Anyone under the age of 19 will need a parent or guardian to sign the waiver prior to the trip departure.

WHAT'S INCLUDED? WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

We include all the equipment required to raft, a Transport Canada certified friendly raft guide, a deluxe BBQ meal (extra charge), and smiles! You'll need to bring clothing appropriate for the weather, something to wear underneath the wetsuit we'll provide you and a towel. On most departures you'll be able to purchase a photo of yourself rafting and have it printed or burned on a CD.

DEPARTURES

Our Elaho Exhilarator Rafting For Cadets adventure runs from May 1 to September 30 We'll meet you at our adventure base near Squamish either at 8:30 AM, 10:00 AM or 2:00 PM depending on your choice of date. You'll be with us for approximately 6-7 hours. Including round trip transportation from Vancouver your day will take 8-9 hours.
